1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the county property tax
2 levies for collection in 2020, and implementing RCW
3 84.55.120.

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. The council is under an obligation by charter to enact revenue
6 measures that support the budget appropriation ordinance by December 1, 2019, for the
7 2020 budget. This ordinance sets the amount of property tax to be collected for the
8 regular property tax levy, the transit levy, the road district levy, the conservation futures
9 levy, the emergency medical services levy and the marine levy. In accordance with
10 RCW 84.55.120, the council has given proper notice of this ordinance to the public.

11 SECTION 2. For collection of the property tax levies in 2020, the council hereby
12 authorizes property tax changes compared to the amounts authorized for collection in
13 2019 as follows:

Regular Levy (includes new 2019 voter-approved parks levy, under Ordinance 18890)	\$46,051,752	6.95%	\$720,758,064
Regular - Transit	\$235,149	0.80%	\$30,184,815

Road District	\$795,204	0.87%	\$92,987,997
Conservation Futures	\$159,677	0.77%	\$21,297,118
Emergency Medical Services (New 2019 voter-approved levy, under Ordinance 18931)	\$37,929,127	28.83%	\$169,468,451
Marine	\$61,174	1.00%	\$6,290,100

- 14 The changes shown above are exclusive of any amounts resulting from new construction
15 valued in 2019, any increases in value of state-assessed property for 2020 and any
16 amounts necessary to fund tax refunds paid in 2019.

17 SECTION 3. Upon enactment, the clerk is directed to forward this ordinance to
18 the assessor in accordance with RCW 84.52.070.
