1 AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of  
 2 \$145,000 to the prosecuting attorney; making a  
 3 supplemental appropriation of \$161,000 to the general fund  
 4 transfer to department of local services; making a  
 5 supplemental appropriation of \$161,000 to general public  
 6 services; and amending the 2019-2020 Biennial Budget  
 7 Ordinance, Ordinance 18835, Sections 31, 43 and 83, as  
 8 amended.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1. Ordinance 18835, Section 31, as amended, is hereby amended to  
 11 read as follows:

12 PROSECUTING ATTORNEY - From the general fund there is hereby  
 13 appropriated to:

14	Prosecuting attorney	\$145,000
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15	The maximum number of FTEs for prosecuting attorney shall be:	1.0
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16 ER1 EXPENDITURE RESTRICTION:

17 Of this appropriation, \$552,000 and 2.0 FTEs, including 1.0 FTE for a deputy  
 18 prosecuting attorney and 1.0 FTE for a data analyst, shall be expended or encumbered  
 19 solely for funding for the prosecuting attorney's office's firearms crime strategy unit. The

20 funding shall be used to continue the existing work of the firearms crime strategy unit  
21 and to develop a regional gun violence intervention strategy to keep individuals from  
22 becoming victims or perpetrators of gun violence. The intervention strategy shall be  
23 developed in partnership with the department of community and human services and the  
24 department of public health, law enforcement and community-based organizations or  
25 nonprofits that serve communities where interventions are likely to occur.

26 ER2 EXPENDITURE RESTRICTION:

27 Of this appropriation, 1.0 FTE and \$145,000 shall be expended or encumbered  
28 primarily to enforce Ordinance XXXX (Proposed Ordinance 2018-0241).

29 P1 PROVIDED THAT:

30 Of this appropriation, \$50,000 shall not be expended or encumbered until the  
31 prosecutor transmits a firearms crime strategy unit report and a motion that should  
32 acknowledge receipt of report and reference the subject matter, the proviso's ordinance,  
33 ordinance section and proviso number in both the title and body of the motion and a  
34 motion acknowledging receipt of the report is passed by the council.

35 The report shall include, but not be limited to: a summary of the work  
36 accomplished by the firearms crime strategy unit; a summary of regional data on firearm  
37 violence; a description of the efforts to develop an intervention strategy to keep  
38 individuals from becoming victims or perpetrators of gun violence; a listing of the  
39 individuals or organizations who participated in the efforts to develop the intervention  
40 strategy; a summary of the interventions, if any, undertaken as a result of the data  
41 provided by the firearms crime strategy unit; and any recommendations for additional  
42 actions or legislation needed to address firearm violence in King County.

43 The prosecuting attorney should file the report and a motion required by this  
44 proviso by January 20, 2020, in the form of a paper original and an electronic copy with  
45 the clerk of the council, who shall retain the original and provide an electronic copy to all  
46 councilmembers, the council chief of staff and the lead staff for the law and justice  
47 committee, or its successor.

48 SECTION 2. Ordinance 18835, Section 43, as amended, is hereby amended to  
49 read as follows:

50 GENERAL FUND TRANSFER TO DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL SERVICES. -

51 From the general fund there is hereby appropriated to:

52	General fund transfer to department of local services	\$161,000
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53 SECTION 3. Ordinance 18835, Section 83, as amended, is hereby amended to  
54 read as follows:

55 GENERAL PUBLIC SERVICES - From the permitting division fund general  
56 public services sub fund there is hereby appropriated to:

57	General public services	\$161,000
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58	The maximum number of FTEs for general public services shall be:	1.0
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59 ER1 EXPENDITURE RESTRICTION:

60 Of this appropriation, no funds shall be expended or encumbered for subarea  
61 planning or the body of work associated with these FTE positions except when needed  
62 for technical assistance or subject matter expertise. Consistent with the council adopted  
63 maximum FTEs in this section, section 81 and section 84 of this ordinance, the subarea  
64 planning FTEs and the bodies of work associated with these FTE positions are moved  
65 from the permitting division to the director's office of the department of local services.

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ER2 EXPENDITURE RESTRICTION:

Of this appropriation, 1.0 FTE and \$121,000 shall be expended or encumbered primarily to enforce Ordinance XXXX (Proposed Ordinance 2018-0241).
