1 AN ORDINANCE adopting and ratifying Growth
2 Management Planning Council Motion 20-1.

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

4 SECTION 1. Findings:

5 A. Growth Management Planning Council Motion 20-1 amends the Urban
6 Growth Boundary map and the Potential Annexation Areas map in the 2012 King County
7 Countywide Planning Policies to adjust the urban growth area boundary in three areas:
8 Woodinville Roundabout; Maple Woods Subdivision; and East Cougar Mountain.

9 B. On February 26, 2020, King County staff briefed the Growth Management
10 Planning Council on the details of the potential changes to the urban growth area under
11 consideration by the King County council.

12 C. On June 24, 2020, the Growth Management Planning Council unanimously
13 adopted Motion 20-1.

14 SECTION 2. The amendment to the 2012 King County Countywide Planning

Ordinance 19233

15 Policies, as shown in Attachment A to this ordinance, is hereby adopted by King County
16 and ratified on behalf of the population of unincorporated King County.

GMPC MOTION NO. 20-1

A MOTION amending the 2012 King County Countywide Planning Policies, as amended; addressing changes to the Urban Growth Area of King County and the resulting changes to the Urban Growth Area Boundary map and Potential Annexation Area map.

WHEREAS, the Washington State Growth Management Act, RCW 36.70A.110 requires counties to designate an urban growth area within which urban growth shall be encouraged and outside of which growth can occur if it is not urban in nature; and

WHEREAS, Countywide Planning Policy G-1 recognizes that King County may initiate amendments to the Urban Growth Area; and

WHEREAS; the King County Executive and the King County Council request the Growth Management Planning Council consider the attached amendments to the Urban Growth Area for eventual adoption by the King County Council and ratification by the cities; and

WHEREAS, Countywide Planning Policies DP-15 through DP-18 outline criteria for changes to the Urban Growth Area; and

WHEREAS, on February 26, 2020, the Growth Management Planning Council received a briefing on the potential changes to the Urban Growth Area under consideration by the King County Council; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council is proposing three amendments to the Urban Growth Area in the 2020 King County Comprehensive Plan.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Growth Management Planning Council of King County hereby recommends that the 2016 King County Countywide Planning Policies Urban Growth Area Boundary Map and the Potential Annexation Areas Map be amended as depicted on the attached maps.

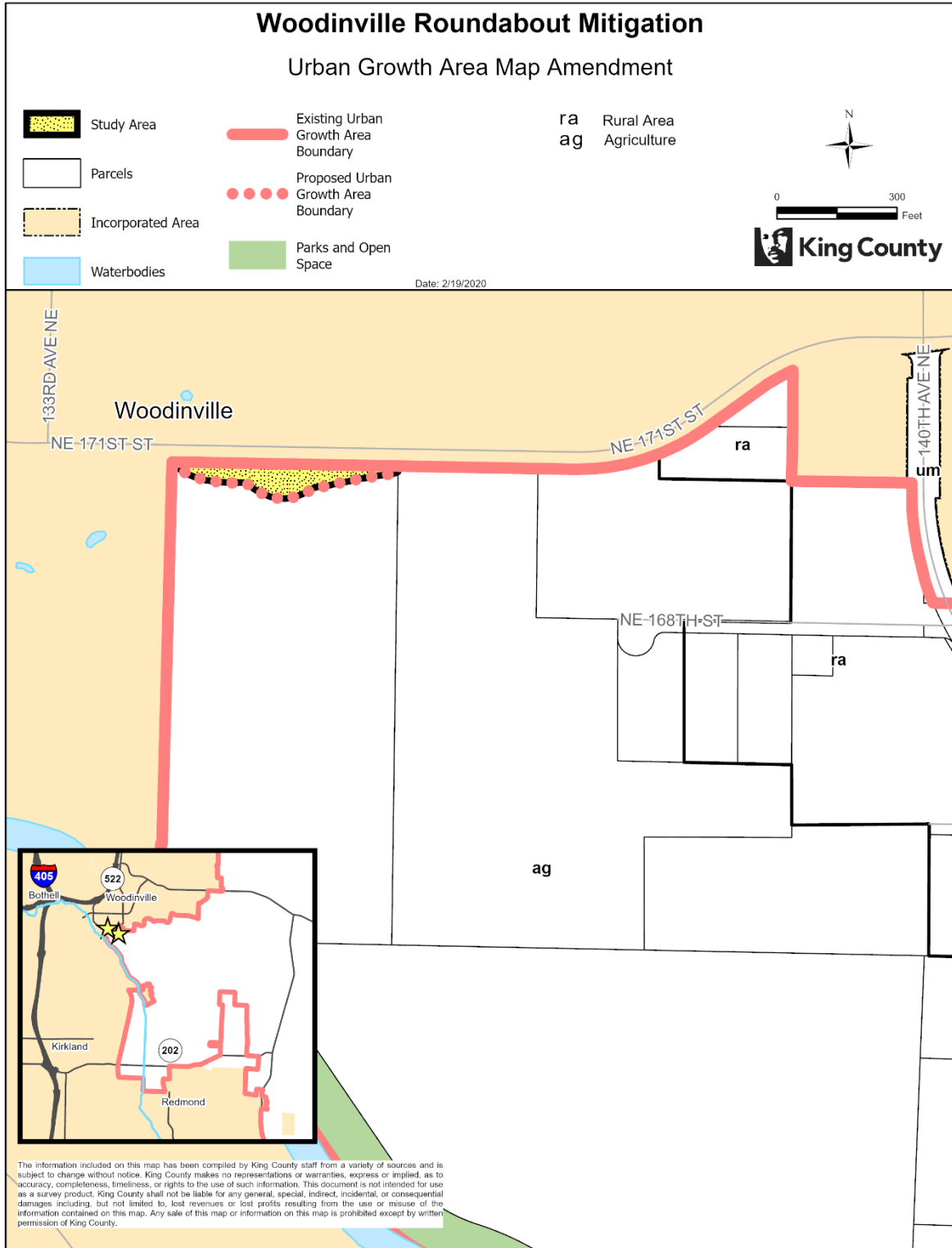
1. Woodinville Roundabout Urban Growth Area

1. Area Adjacent to City of Woodinville

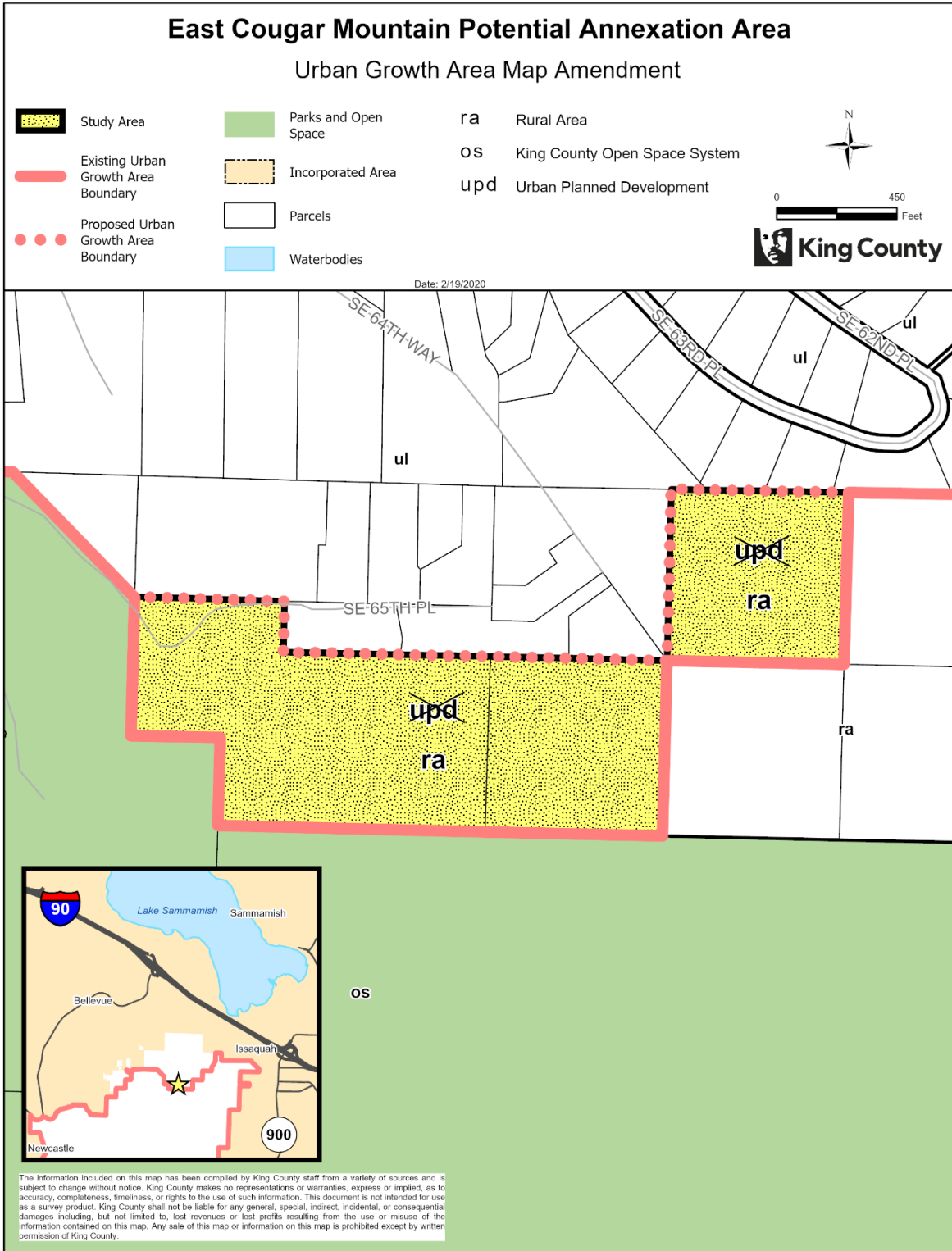
Woodinville Roundabout Urban Growth Area

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
