1 AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive
 2 to enter into a development agreement with Bridge Housing
 3 Corporation and Community Roots Housing to develop and
 4 ground lease county-owned land located at the Northgate
 5 Park and Pool lot, in council district one, for affordable
 6 housing and related purposes.

7 STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 8 1. Consistent with K.C.C. 4.56.070.C.1. and K.C.C. 4.56.085, in 2018
 9 King County issued a request for qualifications and concepts, number
 10 1207-18-VLN ("the RFQ/C"), through which King County sought
 11 proposals for the development of its Northgate Park and Pool lot. Among
 12 other things, the RFQ/C required proposals to include a minimum of two
 13 hundred units of subsidized affordable housing for a minimum of fifty
 14 years to serve households earning up to sixty percent of Area Median
 15 Income ("AMI"), with a mix of unit sizes and configurations, and with a
 16 minimum of ten percent of the units to be "system connected," serving
 17 very-low to extremely-low income households below fifty percent AMI.
 18 2. The RFQ/C resulted in three proposals and King County selected a
 19 developer team and commenced negotiations with the selected team.

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20 3. After extensive negotiations the Metro transit department determined
21 that the county should enter into a development agreement and ground
22 lease a portion of the county-owned land located at the Northgate Park and
23 Pool lot to Bridge Housing Corporation and Community Roots Housing
24 (collectively, "Bridge/CRH") for an affordable housing project to include
25 two hundred thirty-two units of affordable housing for seventy-five years
26 with at least twenty-four units designated for system-connected
27 households with incomes of fifty percent or less of the area median
28 income.

29 4. The Metro transit department successfully negotiated a development
30 agreement, form of ground lease, and related instruments with
31 Bridge/CRH for a portion of the county-owned land located at the
32 Northgate Park and Pool lot.

33 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

34 SECTION 1. The executive is authorized to execute a development agreement
35 for county-owned land located at the Northgate Park and Pool lot to Bridge Housing
36 Corporation and Community Roots Housing, substantially in the form of Attachment A to
37 this ordinance, and to execute all related instruments and take all actions necessary to
38 implement the terms of the development agreement. The executive is authorized to
39 execute a ground lease, substantially in the form of Attachment 5 to the development
40 agreement in Attachment A to this ordinance.

41 SECTION 2. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or

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- 42 circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the
43 provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.



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
