1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the public safety advisory  
2 committee; and amending Ordinance 19249, Section 1, as  
3 amended.

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. Ordinance 19249, Section 1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

6 A. The King County public safety advisory committee is hereby established.

7 B. The purpose of the committee shall be to:

8 1. Engage with and receive input from community stakeholders directly  
9 impacted by the department of public safety and provide guidance to the council and the  
10 executive in the selection, appointment and confirmation process for appointment of the  
11 chief officer of the department of public safety in accordance with Ordinance 19249,  
12 Section 3; and

13 2. Engage with and receive input from community stakeholders directly  
14 impacted by the department of public safety regarding the values stakeholder  
15 communities hold on how law enforcement services should be provided and ways the  
16 county could improve the delivery of law enforcement services to preserve and enhance  
17 public safety, and to provide guidance to the council and the executive on those matters  
18 in accordance with Ordinance 19249, Section 4.

19 C.1. The committee shall include thirteen members of the public, who represent  
20 the geographic, ethnic and economic diversity of the department of public safety's service

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21 area. Two members of the committee shall represent overpoliced communities. Two  
22 members of the committee shall represent rural unincorporated communities. Two  
23 members of the committee shall represent urban unincorporated communities. Two  
24 members of the committee shall represent cities which contract with the department of  
25 public safety for police services. Two members of the committee shall have knowledge  
26 of, or experience related to, law enforcement reform work. One member of the  
27 committee shall represent the Puget Sound Police Managers Association. One member  
28 of the committee shall represent the King County Police Officers Guild. One member of  
29 the committee shall represent the community advisory committee for law enforcement  
30 oversight.

31           2. The executive and the council shall each select one member representing the  
32 following communities or expertise:

33           a. overpoliced communities, which, for the purposes of ~~((this e))~~ Ordinance  
34 19249, are those communities that have simultaneously experienced the greatest  
35 infringement of personal liberty and the greatest under-protection from law enforcement.

36           b. rural unincorporated communities, which, for the purposes of  
37 ~~((e))~~ Ordinance 19249, are those areas located in the rural area of the county;

38           c. urban unincorporated communities, which, for the purposes of ~~((this~~  
39 ~~e))~~ Ordinance 19249 are those located in the in the urban growth areas of unincorporated  
40 King County; and

41           d. a person with knowledge of or experience related to law enforcement reform  
42 work.

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43           3. The oversight committee, established by the interlocal public safety services  
44 agreements with the cities, shall select two members to represent the contract cities on the  
45 advisory committee. The Puget Sound Police Managers Association and the King  
46 County Police Officers Guild shall each select one member from their respective  
47 organizations to represent their organizations on the committee. The community  
48 committee for law enforcement oversight shall select one member to represent it on the  
49 advisory committee.

50           4. Committee members selected by the executive and those members selected  
51 by the council to represent the communities as described in subsection C.2. of this section  
52 and those members selected by the organizations as described in Ordinance 19249,  
53 subsection C.3. of this section are included in Attachment A to ~~((this ordinance))~~this  
54 ordinance. After the effective date of this ordinance, a designee to replace a committee  
55 member who resigns or becomes permanently unable to serve on the committee shall be  
56 approved by motion. The person or entity that selected the committee member for whom  
57 a replacement is required shall select the replacement designee to be approved by motion.  
58 An approved designee must represent the communities or expertise of the committee  
59 member for whom the replacement designee has been selected.

60           5. Once fully constituted, the committee, with assistance from the facilitators  
61 described in Ordinance 19249, Section 6, shall determine its rules and operating  
62 procedures, including, but not limited to, the frequency of committee meetings, the  
63 method by which the committee will determine what to include in the final report  
64 required by Ordinance 19249, Section 5(~~(-as amended)~~)).

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Ordinance 19411 was introduced on 2/22/2022 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 3/15/2022, by the following vote:

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
