1 AN ORDINANCE relating to county fund: and amending  
2 Ordinance 9948, Section 1, as amended, and K.C.C.  
3 4A.200.400.

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. Ordinance 9948, Section 1, as amended, and K.C.C. 4A.200.400  
6 are hereby amended to read as follows:

7 A. There is hereby created the local hazardous waste fund.

8 B. The fund shall be a first tier fund. It is a special revenue fund.

9 C. The director of the department of (~~public health~~) natural resources and parks  
10 shall be the manager of the fund.

11 D. All receipts collected according to the local hazardous waste fee schedule set  
12 by the board of health shall be deposited in the fund.

13 E.1. The King County board of health, or its designated representative, shall be  
14 responsible for the administration of the local hazardous waste fund including the  
15 preparation and issuance of operating procedures deemed necessary to insure the proper  
16 administrative implementation of the policies governing the purpose and use of the fund.

17 2. The fund shall accumulate and disburse financial resources for the  
18 implementation of the local hazardous waste management program as described in the  
19 Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan for Seattle-King County.

Ordinance 19528

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20 F. King County indirect overhead cost allocation charges shall not be levied  
21 directly against the fund.


Ordinance 19528 was introduced on 10/4/2022 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 11/15/2022, by the following vote:
