1 AN ORDINANCE eliminating electronic monitoring fees
2 for all program participants; and repealing Ordinance
3 12917, Section 1, as amended, and K.C.C. 4A.640.010.

4 PREAMBLE:

5 King County's department of adult and juvenile detention through its
6 community corrections division manages an electronic monitoring
7 program as an alternative to secure detention. Program participants are
8 required to pay fees for monitoring and equipment rental pursuant to
9 K.C.C. 4A.640.010. Such fees can impact a person's ability to participate
10 in the program. The executive removed the fee requirements throughout
11 the COVID-19 pandemic in order to make the program accessible to
12 everyone, regardless of their ability to pay. This ordinance removes the
13 fee requirements for the program permanently.

14 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Ordinance 19536

15 SECTION 1. Ordinance 12917, Section 1, as amended, and K.C.C. 4A.640.010
16 are hereby repealed.

Ordinance 19536 was introduced on 10/4/2022 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 11/15/2022, by the following vote:


