1 AN ORDINANCE establishing the Doors Open Program
2 fund; and adding a new section to K.C.C. chapter 4A.200.

3 **STATEMENT OF FACTS:**

4 1. In December 2023, the King County council adopted Ordinance 19710
5 to authorize an additional one-tenth of one percent sales and use tax
6 imposed on all taxable events within the county as defined in chapter
7 82.08, 82.12, or 82.14 RCW for seven years beginning on April 1, 2024,
8 to support cultural organizations through the King County doors open
9 program.

10 2. Ordinance 19710, Section 7, requires the proceeds of the sales and use
11 tax imposed by the county to be deposited in the doors open program fund.

12 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:**

13 **NEW SECTION. SECTION 1.** There is hereby added to K.C.C. chapter 4A.200
14 a new section to read as follows:

15 A. There is hereby created the Doors Open Program fund.

16 B. The fund shall be a first tier fund. It is a special revenue fund.

17 C. The director of the office of performance strategy and budget shall be the
18 manager of the fund.

19 D. The fund shall receive all proceeds of an additional one-tenth of one percent
20 sales and use tax imposed by the county as authorized in chapter 36.160 RCW.

21 E. Proceeds of the sales tax shall be used to support cultural organizations
22 consistent with RCW 36.160.110 and Ordinance 19710, including transfer of proceeds to
23 the cultural development authority, as the county's designated public agency under RCW
24 36.160.070, to perform its functions under Ordinance 19710.

Ordinance 19786 was introduced on 6/18/2024 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 7/9/2024, by the following vote:




