Proposed No. 2025-0292.2 **Sponsors** Dembowski 1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the 2025 levy of property 2 taxes in King County for collection in the year 2026. 3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY: 4 SECTION 1. The county assessor of King County has certified to the 5 metropolitan King County council that the assessed valuation of the County of King as 6 finally equalized amounts to \$912,911,807,935. 7 SECTION 2. The King County council imposes the levies necessary to fund 8 estimated expenditures for the year 2026 as listed in this section. These amounts do not 9 include the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including 10 available surplus and such expenditures as are to be net from bond warrant issues. In 11 accordance with state law, the King County assessor calculated a sum for property taxes 12 available to the county related to new construction, improvements to property, refunds, 13 and any increase in the assessed value of state assessed property.
