Pre-Meeting cross-walk tour (6pm)

Most of the group met early at Big Finn Hill Park to walk thru and assess the proposed cross-walk upgrade across Juanita drive, for safely linking park users between the East and West sections of the park. Multiple access and egress options were observed and discussed for various crossing locations among the group. Mike shared his discussion with Kirkland officials and that they have yet to make any definitive plans on locating the cross walk but that before the next committee meeting would follow-up and provide the group with the latest feedback.

The group discussed various trail re-route options on both the east and west sides but is unable to recommend more specific suggestions until a cross-walk location is determined by the city. However, as a general principal the group expressed a goal to minimize the loss of trail any re-route would impact. This primarily pertains to the east side of the park.

Annual Meeting

Confirmed annual meeting was a "go" for 4/21; communication was sent by Bill and Accomplishments and presentation compiled by Jeanette.

June 3rd Eddie Bauer Project: Volunteers from Eddie Bauer will be assigned two projects in the park.

1) Initial brush clearing of the new trail - Hall's Pass and 2) trail maintenance (mud reduction) on the trail north of NE138 Street between W4 and W1. The exact trail markings for Hall Pass are still under review, led by Troy and Mark to finalize details and approval with KC Parks.

Reviewed Joe P's trail project plan: The committee along with King Co. approved Joe's project plan with only minimal modifications on feature C. All members agreed that Joe's proposed project plan document was comprehensive and well documented and should serve as the standard outline for future projects requiring approval by the committee. Action/next step: Joe to schedule work party

Orchard update: Area is ready for clover seeding. Suggestion of next Saturday (4/23) as possible date for spreading; Janice to send email for availability and volunteers.

Request was made for placing a bench in the orchard area. Mike supported the idea and will look for materials.

Rock Garden sign: Mike approved the suggestion to put up a sign to mark the area.

Hazardous Jump in area E30: Mike confirmed KC Parks removed the jump and suggested a future project to review the Bowl area and build approved features. Further input from the committee suggested integrating the community into the effort too. Specifically, local kids to support design and empower ownership of the park trails and features. Signage could be put up in Park kiosks to communicate effort and engage youth, with project timing for a early summer kick-off to execute.
