#### RESOLUTION NO. 995

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Enumclaw School District No. 216, King County, Washington, providing for the submission to the voters of the District at a special election to be held therein on February 11, 2014, of a proposition authorizing a tax levy to be made annually for four years commencing in 2014 for collection in 2015 on all of the taxable property within the District of \$10,141,083, the estimated dollar rate of tax levy required to produce such an amount being \$3.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value (such assessed value representing 100% of true and fair value unless specifically provided otherwise by law), in 2015 for collection in 2016 of \$10,343,904, the estimated dollar rate of tax levy required to produce such an amount being \$3.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value, in 2016 for collection in 2017 of \$10,550,782, the estimated dollar rate of tax levy required to produce such an amount being \$3.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value, and in 2017 for collection in 2018 of \$10,761,797, the estimated dollar rate of tax levy required to produce such an amount being \$3.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value, all in excess of the maximum tax levy specified by law for school districts without voter approval, for the District's General Fund, the proceeds of such levies to be used to pay general expenses of maintenance and operation, all as more particularly set forth herein; designating the District's Executive Director, Business and Operations and special counsel to receive notice of the ballot title from the Director of Records and Elections of King County, Washington; and providing for other matters properly related thereto, all as more particularly set forth herein.

### RESOLUTION NO. 995

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Enumclaw School District No. 216, King County, Washington, providing for the submission to the voters of the District at a special election to be held therein on February 11, 2014, of a proposition authorizing a tax levy to be made annually for four years commencing in 2014 for collection in 2015 on all of the taxable property within the District of \$10,141,083, the estimated dollar rate of tax levy required to produce such an amount being \$3.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value (such assessed value representing 100% of true and fair value unless specifically provided otherwise by law), in 2015 for collection in 2016 of \$10,343,904, the estimated dollar rate of tax levy required to produce such an amount being \$3.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value, in 2016 for collection in 2017 of \$10,550,782, the estimated dollar rate of tax levy required to produce such an amount being \$3.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value, and in 2017 for collection in 2018 of \$10,761,797, the estimated dollar rate of tax levy required to produce such an amount being \$3.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value, all in excess of the maximum tax levy specified by law for school districts without voter approval, for the District's General Fund, the proceeds of such levies to be used to pay general expenses of maintenance and operation, all as more particularly set forth herein; designating the District's Executive Director, Business and Operations and special counsel to receive notice of the ballot title from the Director of Records and Elections of King County, Washington; and providing for other matters properly related thereto, all as more particularly set forth herein.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF ENUMCIAW SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 216, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

- Section 1. Findings and Determinations. The Board of Directors (the "Board") of Enumcial School District No. 216, King County, Washington (the "District"), hereby makes the following findings and determinations:
- (a) Calendar year 2014 is the last year of collection of the District's current four-year General Fund maintenance and operation tax levy, which was authorized pursuant to Resolution No. 946, adopted by the Board on November 23, 2009, and a special election held and conducted within the District on February 9, 2010.
- (b) With the expiration of the District's current four-year General Fund maintenance and operation tax levy, it appears certain that the money which will be available for the General Fund for the school years 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 will be insufficient to permit the District to meet the educational needs of its students, operate its educational programs and pay general expenses of maintenance and operation support thereof, all as more particularly set forth in Section 3 of this resolution, during such school years, and that it is necessary that a replacement excess tax levy of \$10,141,083 be made in 2014 for collection in

2015, \$10,343,904 be made in 2015 for collection in 2016, \$10,550,782 be made in 2016 for collection in 2017, and \$10,761,797 be made in 2017 for collection in 2018 for the District's General Fund to provide the money required to meet those expenses.

- (c) The District's proposed four-year General Fund maintenance and operation tax levy authorized in this resolution provides for approximately the same purpose as the District's expiring four-year General Fund maintenance and operation tax levy.
- (d) The District is authorized pursuant to Article VII, Section 2(a) of the Washington Constitution and Revised Code of Washington ("RCW") 84.52.053 to submit to the District's voters at a special election, for their approval or rejection, the proposition of whether the District shall levy excess property taxes for support of the District's maintenance and operation expenses.
- Calling of Election. The Director of Records and Elections of King County, Washington, as ex officio Supervisor of Elections (the "Auditor"), is requested to call and conduct a special election in the District in the manner provided by law to be held therein on February 11, 2014, for the purpose of submitting to the District's voters, for their approval or rejection, the proposition of whether a replacement General Fund maintenance and operation tax levy shall be made annually for four years commencing in 2014 for collection in 2015 on all of the taxable property within the District of \$10,141,083, the estimated dollar rate of tax levy required to produce such an amount being \$3.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value (such assessed value representing 100% of true and fair value unless specifically provided otherwise by law), in 2015 for collection in 2016 of \$10,343,904, the estimated dollar rate of tax levy required to produce such an amount being \$3.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value, in 2016 for collection in 2017 of \$10,550,782, the estimated dollar rate of tax levy required to produce such an amount being \$3.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value, and in 2017 for collection in 2018 of \$10,761,797, the estimated dollar rate of tax levy required to produce such an amount being \$3.89 per \$1,000 of assessed value, all in excess of the maximum tax levy specified by law for school districts without voter approval. The exact tax levy rate may be adjusted based upon the actual assessed value of the taxable property within the District at the time of the levy.
- Section 3. Use of Levy Proceeds. If the proposition authorized by this resolution is approved by the requisite numbers of voters, the District will be authorized to levy excess property taxes and use the proceeds of such levies to meet the educational needs of its students, operate its educational programs and pay general expenses of maintenance and operation support thereof during the school years 2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2016-2017, 2017-2018 and 2018-2019, all as may be authorized by law and deemed necessary by the Board. Pending the receipt of those taxes, the District may issue short-term obligations pursuant to chapter 39.50 RCW or contract indebtedness pursuant to RCW 28A.530.080. Upon receipt, the District may use those taxes to repay such short-term obligations or indebtedness, all as may be authorized by law and deemed necessary and advisable by the Board.

## REPLACEMENT MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION LEVY

The Board of Directors of Enumclaw School District No. 216 adopted Resolution No. 995, concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to meet the educational needs of its students by levying the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund maintenance and operation expenses:

<u>Necessary Duties</u>. The Secretary to the Board (the "Secretary") or his designee is directed to: (a) present a certified copy of this resolution to the Auditor no later than December 27, 2013; and (b) perform such other duties as are necessary or required by law to submit to the District's voters at the aforesaid special election, for their approval or rejection, the proposition of whether the District shall levy excess property taxes for support of the District's maintenance and operation expenses. All actions of the District or its staff or officers taken prior to the effective date of this resolution and consistent with the objectives and terms of this resolution are ratified and confirmed.

Section 6. Notices Relating to Ballot Title. For purposes of receiving notice of the exact language of the ballot title required by RCW 29A.36.080, the Board hereby designates (a) the District's Executive Director, Business and Operations (Tim Madden), telephone: 360.802.7107; fax: 360.802.7123; email: tim madden@enumclaw.wednet.edu; and (b) special counsel, Foster Pepper PLLC (Jim McNeill), telephone: 206.447.5339; fax 800.533.2284; email: mcnei@foster.com, as the individuals to whom the Auditor shall provide such notice. The Secretary is authorized to approve changes to the ballot title, if any, deemed necessary by the Auditor or the King County Prosecuting Attorney.

Section 7. Severability. If any provision of this resolution shall be declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, then such provision shall be null and void and shall be separable from the remaining provisions of this resolution and shall in no way affect the validity of the other provisions of this resolution, or of the levy or collection of excess property taxes authorized herein.

Section 8. <u>Effective Date</u>. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
