RESOLUTION NO. 2013-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISSAQUAH, WASHINGTON, REQUESTING THAT THE KING COUNTY DIRECTOR OF ELECTIONS HOLD A SPECIAL ELECTION FEBRUARY 11, 2014 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLACING ON THE BALLOT A PROPOSITION CONCERNING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE KLAHANIE ANNEXATION AREA AND ASSUMPTION OF EXISTING CITY INDEBTEDNESS BY PROPERTY WITHIN THE KLAHANIE ANNEXATION AREA IF ANNEXED.

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2013, the City Council of the City of Issaquah adopted Resolution No. 2013-07 calling for an election combining in a single ballot proposition the questions of annexation of the Klahanie PAA and assumption of indebtedness, and directing the administration to file a notice of intent to annex the Klahanie PAA with the Washington State Boundary Review Board, and

WHEREAS, a copy of Resolution No. 2013-07 was filed with the King County Council and the Washington State Boundary Review Board in accordance with RCW 35A.14.015, and

WHEREAS, the Boundary Review Board held a public hearing on the proposed annexation on September 18th and 19th, 2013, and

WHEREAS, the Boundary Review Board, following an unanimous vote, approved the annexation on November 6, 2013, and

WHEREAS, the City has determined to call for a special election to be held on February 11, 2014 and to submit the questions of annexation and assumption of indebtedness as a single combined ballot question as authorized by RCW 35A.14.085,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISSAQUAH, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Resolution No. 2013-07, attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, the City Council hereby requests the King County Director of Elections to hold a special election on February 11, 2014 and to submit to the qualified electors of the Klahanie PAA, which is identified and legally described in Exhibit A to the aforementioned Resolution No. 2013-07, a single combined proposition authorizing (1) the Klahanie PAA to be annexed to the City of Issaquah subject to pre-approved zoning regulations; and (2) the assumption of proportionate share of the City's then-outstanding indebtedness by property within the Klahanie PAA.

Section 2. The ballot title of the proposition referenced above in Section 1 shall read substantially as follows:

Klahanie Annexation Proposal

The Issaquah City Council is calling for an election on the proposed annexation of the Klahanie Annexation Area, which is located in unincorporated King County.

If annexed, the Klahanie Annexation Area would:

- Be subject to zoning regulations as provided in Ordinance No. 2695.
- Assume a proportionate share of the City's thenoutstanding indebtedness.
- Be assessed and taxed at the same rate and upon the same basis as property within the City.

Shall the Klahanie Annexation Area be annexed to the City of Issaquah?

☐ For annexation, adoption of proposed zoning regulations and assumption of proportionate share of then-outstanding indebtedness

☐ Against annexation, adoption of proposed zoning regulations and assumption of proportionate share of then-outstanding indebtedness

Section 3. The Mayor and City Attorney are authorized to make such minor adjustments to the wording of such proposition as may be recommended by the King County Director of Elections, as long as the intent of the proposition remains clear and as approved by the City Council.

Section 4. A certified copy of this resolution shall be transmitted to the King County Department of Records and Elections.

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-07

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISSAQUAH, WASHINGTON, DECLARING THE CITY'S INTENT TO ANNEX AN UNINCORPORATED AREA OF KING COUNTY COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE KLAHANIE POTENTIAL ANNEXATION AREA; DESCRIBING THE BOUNDARIES OF SUCH AREA; CALLING FOR AN ELECTION TO BE HELD SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS WITHIN SUCH AREA THE PROPOSAL FOR ANNEXATION: FURTHER SUBMITTING TO SAID VOTERS PROPOSITION FOR THE ANNEXATION AREA TO ASSUME PROPORTIONATE SHARE **OF** THE CITY'S INDEBTEDNESS EXISTING AS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE ANNEXATION AND TO BE ASSESSED AND TAXED AT THE SAME RATE AND UPON THE SAME BASIS AS OTHER PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY; ENTERING LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS; AND PROVIDING DIRECTION TO STAFF.

WHEREAS, there is located contiguous to the boundaries of the City of Issaquah that certain unincorporated territory comprised of approximately 1,243 acres and known commonly as the Klahanie Potential Annexation Area; and

WHEREAS, the Klahanie Potential Annexation Area is located entirely within the City's Urban Growth Area, and is identified and legally described as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full; and

WHEREAS, to the best of the City's knowledge and belief, there are currently 6,450 registered voters residing within the Klahanie Potential Annexation Area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to annex the Klahanie Potential Annexation

Area into the City of Issaquah, and to call for an election submitting the proposal for annexation
to the voters of said area; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ISSAQUAH, WASHINGTON,

HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Findings. The City Council hereby adopts the above recitals in support of the annexation proposed by this resolution. The Council further finds that the best interests and general welfare of the City of Issaquah would be served by the proposed annexation.

Section 2. Combined Election On Annexation Proposal Called. The Issaquah City Council hereby calls for a combined election to be held submitting to the voters of the unincorporated territory commonly known as the Klahanie Potential Annexation Area (1) the proposal of whether said territory shall be annexed into the City of Issaquah, in accordance with the process set forth at RCW 35A.14.015 et seq.; and (2) the proposition set forth in Section 3. The City of Issaquah shall pay the cost of the annexation election.

Section 3. Combined Election On Assumption of Indebtedness and Taxation Called. Combined pursuant to RCW 35A.14.085 in the same ballot proposition as the proposal for annexation set forth in Section 2 of this resolution, there shall also be submitted to the voters of the Klahanie Potential Annexation Area the proposition of whether, upon annexation, all property within the annexation area shall be assessed and taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as property within the City of Issaquah, and taxed to pay for all or any portion of the thenoutstanding indebtedness of the City of Issaquah, which indebtedness has been approved by the voters, contracted for, or incurred prior to, or existing at, the date of annexation.

Section 4. Proposed Zoning. Pursuant to RCW 35A.14.330 and RCW 35A.14.340, proposed zoning regulations for the area to be annexed shall be established to be effective upon annexation.

Section 5. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy

of this resolution with the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board in accordance with RCW 35A.14.015.

ANNEXATION KLAHANIE
