## VASHON ISLAND SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 402 KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON

## **RESOLUTION NO. 699**

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Directors of Vashon Island School District #402, King County, Washington providing for the submission to the qualified Electors of the District at a special election to be held therein on February 11, 2014, of the proposition of whether a tax of \$3,774,125 should be levied in 2014 for collection in 2015, whether a tax of \$3,962,831 should be levied in 2015 for collection in 2016, whether a tax of \$4,160,973 should be levied in 2016 for collection in 2017, and whether a tax of \$4,343,912 should be levied in 2017 for collection in 2018; said taxes being for the District's General Fund, as a replacement levy, to pay part of the general expenses of the educational programs and district operations. Be it further resolved that if the February 11, 2014 levy is not approved by the qualified Electors of the District, the Board of Directors of Vashon Island School District #402, King County, Washington provides for the re-submission of said levy values to the qualified Electors of the District at a special election to be held on April 22, 2014.

WHEREAS, the money in and to be paid into the General Fund of Vashon Island School District #402, King County, Washington, by State and Federal Authority, during the 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, and 2018-19 school years will be insufficient to enable the District to pay for necessary educational programs and district operations, and to meet the goals of Vashon Island School District including Student Assessment, Facilities Planning, Communication to the Community, and Operations and Fiscal Planning; and

WHEREAS, in order to properly provide for such educational goals, the board of Directors of the District deems it necessary to levy the following taxes for the District's General Fund upon all the taxable property within the District in excess of the maximum annual tax levy permitted by law to be levied within the District without a vote of the electors:

- A. A tax of approximately \$1.74 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation to provide \$3,774,125 said levy to be made in 2014 for collection in 2015; and
- B. A tax of approximately \$1.74 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation to provide \$3,962,831 said levy to be made in 2015 for collection in 2016; and
- C. A tax of approximately \$1.74 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation to provide \$4,160,973 said levy to be made in 2016 for collection in 2017; and
- D. A tax of approximately \$1.73 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation to provide \$4,343,912 said levy to be made in 2017 for collection in 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution and laws of the State of Washington require that the question of whether or not such taxes may be levied must be submitted to the qualified electors of the District for their ratification or rejection:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Vashon Island School District No. 402, King County, Washington, as follows;

<u>Section 1</u>: The following taxes for the District's General Fund should be levied upon all the taxable property within the district in excess of the maximum annual tax levy permitted by law to be levied within the district without a vote of the electors;

- A. A tax of approximately \$1.74 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation to provide \$3,774,125 said levy to be made in 2014 for collection in 2015; and
- B. A tax of approximately \$1.74 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation to provide \$3,962,831 said levy to be made in 2015 for collection in 2016; and
- C. A tax of approximately \$1.74 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation to provide \$4,160,973 said levy to be made in 2016 for collection in 2017; and
- D. A tax of approximately \$1.73 per thousand dollars of assessed valuation to provide \$4,343,912 said levy to be made in 2017 for collection in 2018.

Upon approval by the voters of the proposition set forth below, the District may use the proceeds of said levies during the school years 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, and 2018-19 to pay such part of the general expenses of educational programs and District operations during such school years as may be authorized or allowed by law for the use of such levy funds.

<u>Section 2</u>: The King County Department of Records and Elections, as ex-office supervisor of elections in King County is hereby requested to conduct said special election to be held on said date and to submit to the qualified electors of the District the proposition hereinafter set forth.

The Secretary of the Board of Directors is hereby authorized and directed to certify said proposition in the following form:

The Board of Directors of Vashon Island School District No. 402 adopted Resolution No. 699, concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operation expenses. This proposition would support the District to meet its educational goals by levying the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund maintenance and operation expenses:
