RESOLUTION NO. 2015.05**

A RESOLUTION OF BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE KING COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT #28 AUTHORIZING THE EXPANSION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FROM THREE TO FIVE MEMBERS AND REQUESTING THAT THE ISSUE BE PLACED BEFORE THE VOTERS OF KING COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT #28 ON THE GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT FOR NOVEMBER 2015.

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire District #28 (Fire District) under Resolution #11-006 placed the issue of expanding the Board of Fire Commissioners from three to five members on the November 2011 General Election Ballot for consideration by the electorate of King County Fire District #28, and

Whereas, the referred to ballot measure failed, and


Whereas, the Fire Commissioners of the Fire District desire to place the issue again before the electorate.

Now, therefore, King County Fire District #28, Board of Commissioners do hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1: That the question of expanding the Board of the Fire Commissioners from three members to five members be placed on the November 2015 regular election ballot for consideration by the electorate of King County Fire District #28.

Section 2: If any provision of this Resolution is determined to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remaining provisions of this Resolution shall remain in force and effect.
