


SI VIEW METROPOLITAN PARK DISTRICT, WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 2015-02

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Park Commissioners of Si View Metropolitan Park District, Washington, providing for the submission to the qualified electors of the District at an election to be held on November 3, 2015, of a proposition authorizing a one-year excess property tax levy to be collected in the year 2016 to provide funds to support and continue operating park and recreation facilities and to provide services and programs.

SI VIEW METROPOLITAN PARK DISTRICT, WASHINGTON RESOLUTION NO. 2015-02

A RESOLUTION of the Board of Park Commissioners of Si View Metropolitan Park District, Washington, providing for the submission to the qualified electors of the District at an election to be held on November 3, 2015, of a proposition authorizing a one-year excess property tax levy to be collected in the year 2016 to provide funds to support and continue operating park and recreation facilities and to provide services and programs.

WHEREAS, Si View Metropolitan Park District, Washington (the "District") operates park and recreation facilities and programs, including but not limited to the Si View Community Center and Pool, parks, playfields, playgrounds, sports programs, walking and biking trails, summer camps, and after-school recreation programs for youth and teens, which require funding for maintenance and operations; and

WHEREAS, the District is authorized to impose a regular ad valorem tax levy without voter approval in an amount up to \$0.75 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation; and

WHEREAS, at an election held on November 4, 2014 and pursuant to RCW 35.61.210 and RCW 84.52.052, the qualified electors of the District approved a proposition authorizing a one-year excess property tax levy for collection in 2015 for the purpose of funding operations and maintenance of District park and recreation facilities, programs and services (the "2015 O&M Excess Levy"); and

WHEREAS, the 2015 O&M Excess Levy is scheduled to expire at the end of 2015 and as a result, the District projects that its property tax levy rate in support of District programs and facilities, and corresponding revenues, will be significantly reduced from \$0.23 per \$1,000 in

2015 to \$0.02 per \$1,000 in 2016, which is projected to reduce property tax revenues from \$561,026 in 2015 to \$57,716 in 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners of the District (the "Board") and District staff foresee increased demand for park and recreation services and programs which cannot be adequately met with projected revenues for the years 2016 and thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to ask the voters in the District to authorize a oneyear excess property tax levy for 2016 for the purpose of funding operations and maintenance of District park and recreation facilities, programs and services; and

WHEREAS, if approved by the voters in the District, the District would be authorized to levy a one-year excess property tax on all taxable property within the District at an approximate rate of \$0.14 per \$1,000 of assessed value, for collection in 2016, which would help maintain current funding for the day-to-day operations, recreational programs, basic safety, and on-going maintenance of Si View Community Center and Pool, parks and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the conditions here and above set forth require the holding of a special election in the District;

BY THE **BOARD** OF **PARK** THEREFORE, BEIT RESOLVED COMMISSIONERS OF THE ST **VIEW** METROPOLITAN **PARK** DISTRICT, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Findings. The Board hereby finds that it is in the best interests of the residents of the District to provide funds to support and continue operating park and recreation facilities and to provide services and programs, including without limitation maintaining and operating the Si View Community Center and Swimming Pool, parks, playfields and

playgrounds, and walking and biking trails, and providing fitness and youth sports programs, summer camps, and after school-recreation programs for youth and teens.

Section 2. Maintenance and Operations Levy. It is hereby found and declared that the best interests of the District require the submission to the qualified electors of the District of the proposition whether the District shall levy a one-year excess property tax above the regular property tax levy for their ratification or rejection at an election to be held on November 3, 2015. The Director of King County Elections, as *ex officio* supervisor of elections in King County, Washington, is hereby requested to call and conduct such election to be held within the District on such day and to submit to the qualified electors of the District for their approval or rejection, a proposition herein set forth. The election shall be held by all mail-in ballot.

The Clerk of the Board of Park Commissioners is hereby authorized and directed to certify the following proposition to the Director of King County Elections, as *ex officio* supervisor of elections in King County, Washington, in substantially the following form, with such revisions as may be necessary:
