- A RESOLUTION of the Board of Park Commissioners of Si View Metropolitan Park District, Washington, providing for the submission to the qualified electors of the District at an election to be held on November 8, 2011, of a proposition authorizing a one-year excess property tax levy to be collected in the year 2012 pursuant to RCW 35.61.210 to provide funds to support and continue operating park and recreation facilities and to provide services and programs.

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-03

- A RESOLUTION of the Board of Park Commissioners of Si View Metropolitan Park District, Washington, providing for the submission to the qualified electors of the District at an election to be held on November 8, 2011, of a proposition authorizing a one-year excess property tax levy to be collected in the year 2012 pursuant to RCW 35.61.210 to provide funds to support and continue operating park and recreation facilities and to provide services and programs.

WHEREAS, the Si View Metropolitan Park District, Washington (the "District") operates park and recreation facilities and programs, including but not limited to the Si View Community Center and Pool, parks, playfields, playgrounds, sports programs, walking and biking trails, summer camps, and after-school recreation programs for youth and teens, which require maintenance and operating funds; and

WHEREAS, the District is authorized to impose a regular ad valorem tax levy without voter approval in an amount up to \$0.75 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation; and

WHEREAS, the 2011 regular property tax levy in support of District programs and facilities is \$0.55 per \$1,000 of assessed value, and due to prorationing, the recession, current economic conditions, and decreasing property tax revenues within the District, the District projects that the tax levy rate will be reduced in 2012 to \$0.09 per \$1,000 of assessed value; and

WHEREAS, as a result, the District projects that property tax revenues will be reduced from \$1,183,529 in 2011 to \$191,500 in 2012 based on the anticipated tax levy rate; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners of the District (the "Board") and District staff foresee increased demand for park and recreation services and programs which cannot be adequately met with projected revenues for the years 2012 and thereafter; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2011-02, the District will submit to the qualified electors of the District at an election to be held on November 8, 2011, a proposition whether \$0.25 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation of the District's existing regular property tax levy shall be protected from prorationing under RCW 84.52.010(3)(b) for a period of six years; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.61.210 authorizes the voters in the District to authorize a one-year excess property tax levy for the purpose of funding operations and maintenance of District park and recreation facilities, programs and services; and

WHEREAS, if approved by the voters in the District, the District would be authorized to levy a one-year excess property tax on all taxable property within the District at an approximate rate of \$0.21 per \$1,000 of assessed value, for collection in 2012, which would help maintain current funding for the day-to-day operations, recreational programs, basic safety, and on-going maintenance of Si View Community Center and Pool, parks and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the conditions here and above set forth require the holding of a special election in the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS OF THE SI VIEW METROPOLITAN PARK DISTRICT, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Findings. The Board hereby finds that it is in the best interests of the residents of the District to provide funds to support and continue operating park and recreation facilities and to provide services and programs, including without limitation maintaining and operating the Si View Community Center and Swimming Pool, parks, playfields and playgrounds, and walking and biking trails, and providing fitness and youth sports programs, summer camps, and after school-recreation programs for youth and teens.

Section 2. Maintenance and Operations Levy. It is hereby found and declared that the best interests of the District require the submission to the qualified electors of the District of the proposition whether the District shall levy a one-year excess property tax above the regular property tax levy for their ratification or rejection at an election to be held on November 8, 2011. The Director of King County Elections, as *ex officio* supervisor of elections in King County, Washington, is hereby requested to call and conduct such election to be held within the District on such day and to submit to the qualified electors of the District for their approval or rejection, a proposition herein set forth. The election shall be held by all mail-in ballot.

The Clerk of the Board of Park Commissioners is hereby authorized and directed to certify the following proposition to the Director of King County Elections, as *ex officio* supervisor of elections in King County, Washington, in substantially the following form, with such revisions as may be necessary:

ONE-YEAR OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE LEVY

The Board of Directors of the Si View Metropolitan Park District adopted Resolution No. 2011-03 concerning a proposition for basic safety, maintenance and operations. This proposition would maintain current operations, facilities and programs, including the Si View Community Center and Pool, parks, playfields, playgrounds, sports programs, trails, adult programming, summer camps, and after-school recreation programs for youth and teens, by authorizing the District to levy a one-year excess property tax levy on all taxable property within the District at an approximate rate of \$0.21/\$1,000 of assessed value to provide approximately \$462,000, to be collected in 2012.



Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall be in full force and effective from and after its adoption and approval.


